

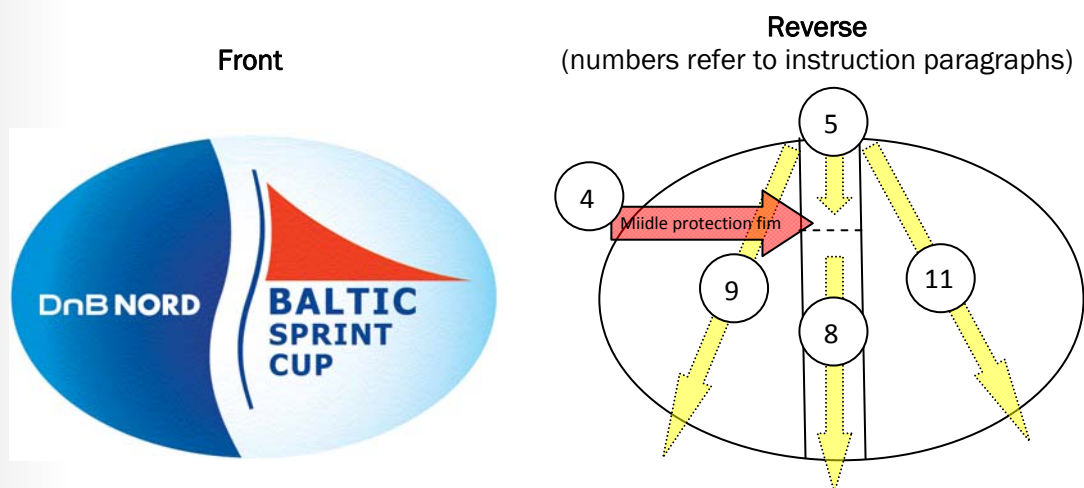
How to fix the Bow Stickers



The bow stickers must be firmly stuck on each side of the bow like this:



1. Wash the surface area carefully (without any polish!) – just use simple soap or mild detergent. Take care that all salt, oil and other dirt is entirely removed.
2. Dry the area 100%.
3. Make some very small boundary marks with a lead or wax pencil
4. Locate on the reverse of the bow sticker an 11cm-wide vertical strip of protective film.



5. Peel from the top the first 20 cm of protective film (don't cut it, just leave it hanging)
6. Fix this middle uncovered part carefully to your boat.
7. Check that the sticker fits within your marks.
8. Remove the rest of the vertical strip of protective film and
9. keeping the sticker in position, peel off the protective film nearest the bows, working slowly from top centre, diagonally towards the bottom edge nearest the bows and
10. as you work, gently remove any air bubbles with the squeegee.
11. After you've finished the half of the sticker nearest the bows, carry out the same process with the section nearest the stern, again working from top centre, diagonally to the bottom edge nearest the stern
12. After finishing the first bow sticker go to the other side and do the same.
13. After, not before (! !) you have finished the work ask your skipper for a Gin Tonic.
